

Terryville Lions Club Annual Scholarship Award Program

The **Terryville Lions Club** has established an annual scholarship program to benefit local students. The President's Award, the Lions Memorial Award, and the Dorothy Pisconski Memorial Award have been established to benefit local community students who desire to pursue their education beyond high school. These are need based awards for scholastically eligible students who are service oriented and actively involved in their school and community.

Purpose:

To assist high school seniors who are continuing their education at an accredited institution and to help someone who might otherwise not be able to pursue additional education.

Awards:

One \$1,000 scholarship, the Lions Memorial Award, renewable each year to a maximum of \$4,000 to be awarded to a graduating senior.

One \$1,000 scholarship, the President's Award, renewable each year to a maximum of \$4,000 to be awarded to a graduating senior.

One \$1,000 scholarship, the Dorothy Pisconski Memorial Award. This will be awarded to a graduating senior pursuing studies in the Education field and is a one time non-renewable award.

Eligibility:

The applicant must be a high school senior residing in the Town of Plymouth.

Applicants may be required to be interviewed at the discretion of the Terryville Lions Scholarship Committee.

It is required that all applications have a Resume, a Transcript, and an Essay attached. All questions on the application form must be answered and it must be signed by the applicant and their parent/guardian and dated to be considered for an award.

Additional information concerning special/unusual circumstances should be described in a separate attachment.

Applicants must return the completed application form to the High School Guidance Office.

Scholarship recipients will be notified of their award prior to July 1st.

Scholarship applications will be judged on the following basis:

Financial Need

Character

School Citizenship & Leadership

Community Service & Involvement

Achievement

Scholastic Standing

While not a requirement, it should be noted that Leo Club Members may receive special consideration.

Immediate family of the Terryville Lions Club members are eligible to receive this award, but will receive no special consideration.

The Terryville Lions Club reserves the right not to issue an award if no applicant adequately fulfills the requirements.

Renewable awards will be based upon satisfactory continued academic standing at an accredited institution and satisfactory notification to the Terryville Lions Club Scholarship Committee of such academic standing.

No advances on awards or increases in awards will be made by the scholarship committee.

All awards must be claimed within eight (8) years of the original award.
